Privacy policy and cookies

The service provider pursuant to Section 13 of the Telemedia Act (Telemediengesetz, TMG) and the responsible agent in accordance with Section 3 paragraph 7 of the Federal Data Protection Act (Bundesdatenschutzgesetz, BDSG) of the website www.myschwalbe.com is GOVECS AG.

Hereinafter, we will inform you about the collection of your personal data when using our website. Personal data is all data that relates to you personally, such as your name, address, email addresses, IP address and user behaviour.

When using the website for information purposes only, i.e. if you do not make a reservation or place an order through the website, if you do not contact us using the form on the website or otherwise transmit information to us, we do not collect personal data, with the exception of data that your browser transmits to enable you to visit the website. This information consists of the operating system used, browser type (including language and version), IP address, date and time of the visit, contents of the request (specific page), amount of data transferred, time and website from which the request is received.

When you create a customer account when ordering products or services, we save your data for the purpose of performance of the contract and delete it as soon as we are no longer legally obliged to store it. Required entries necessary for the execution of the contracts are separately marked; other entries are voluntary.

We use the data you enter for processing your reservation or order made in our online shop. In addition we continue to give your address data to an assigned courier service and, if necessary, your payment data to our bank. We delete this data after execution of the contract and expiration of statutory tax and commercial retention obligations.

Personal data is used by us insofar as this is necessary for the establishment, implementation and termination of the contractual obligation between you and us, or to protect our legitimate interests, for purposes of the technical administration of the websites, for customer administration and for product surveys and marketing, only to the extent necessary and only with your consent. Additional use or transfer of your personal data to a third party shall only be done with your consent, or when it is necessary for the purposes of contractual fulfilment. This website uses Google Analytics, a Web analysis service of Google Inc. ("Google"). Cookies

Cookies may be used on the GOVECS website. Cookies are text files that contain information to identify returning visitors exclusively for the duration of your visit to our website. Cookies are stored on your computer's hard disk and do no harm there. The information stored in the cookies is stored separately from any other personal data that may be given to us. Particularly, the data of the cookies is not linked to your other personal data, and personal data is not collected through the cookies if you have not consented to this. Cookies save you from having to input data multiple times, facilitate the transmission of specific contents and help us to identify particularly popular areas of our website. This makes us able to align the contents of our website exactly to your needs. If you wish, you can disable the use of cookies at any time through your browser settings. We use cookies on our website that are automatically deleted when you close the browser. These particularly include session cookies. Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are absolutely necessary for you to properly use our website and its features.

Functional cookies

With these cookies, we can improve the operation and the performance of our website and provide you with different functions. This includes the language setting you have selected, which is stored in a functional cookie.

• Performance cookies

Performance cookies allow us to collect information about how you use our website. For example, this means we can see which areas of our website are especially interesting for the user and are commonly used. Thus, it is possible to target the content of our website to the needs of the user, and to improve our services for you. No personal data is collected through these cookies.



• Third-party cookies

These cookies are used by third parties such as Google. They are used to optimise this site. You can learn more about Google cookies in the Google Analytics section of this privacy policy.
